The winery is a hive of activity. We are busy bottling our new vintage aromatic whites, vibrant rosés, and fresh sparklings. Meanwhile, our reds are finishing off their malolactic fermentation, tucked away and bedded down in oak for a stay cozy over the winter months ahead.

Out in the vineyard, Mother Nature has been marching to her own beat. It has been an unusually warm autumn, which means the vines have been very slow to change colour and are stubbornly holding onto their leaves. We are playing a patient waiting game, as we need those leaves to drop completely before we can begin our winter pruning. Because of the delay, we suspect the secateurs won't come out until late July this year.

We have some very exciting team news to share! We are absolutely thrilled to welcome Shannon Oliver to the MyattsField family. Shannon is joining us part-time in the role of Events and Marketing Manager. We are super excited to have her on board, so keep a close eye out for all the fun things and fantastic events she'll be bringing your way soon, including the next edition of Tete a Tete a Trois of which there is a teaser in your pack.

Now, the part we are not so excited about, nevertheless, important house business regarding club pricing. We have always done our absolute best to absorb rising costs, but we have reached a point where we need to adjust our pricing. Starting with the next dispatch (Spring for our 4 season members and Summer for our 2 season members), the Left Field Club pack will be increasing to \$130. We have held off on this price rise for as long as possible, but a significant increase in the cost of all our raw materials, combined with the financial impact of the government's container deposit scheme, we can no longer maintain the old rate. You will also notice an increase to bottle prices at cellar door come August 1.

On a similar note, Australia Post has implemented multiple price hikes over the last few years. We have absorbed these freight increases for a long time, but we are no longer able to foot the entire bill. To keep things as fair and simple as possible, we will be restructuring our shipping rates as of August 1st. Freight charges will now be \$10 for metro Perth, \$15 for regional WA, and \$25 for our interstate members.

We are incredibly grateful for your ongoing support, loyalty, and shared love of Left Field wines. It is because of you that we can keep doing what we love, and we can't wait for you to unpack and enjoy this latest selection.

Winter Pack 2026:

- **2024 Tete a Tete a Trois Chenin** – Teaser - This is a competition held amongst the three winemakers or a head-to-head by three. One parcel of fruit is sourced and divided between the winemakers; The Founder, The Flyer and The Factotum. Each winemaker then makes their own expression of said varietal. This competition was Chenin Blanc. Which wine did you receive? Did your LFC friend receive something different? Are you going to taste them together? Or are you going to join us at a Tete a Tete a Trois event where you can taste all three side by side to determine which wine is the best?
- **2025 LFC Grenache** – Made exclusively for the Left Field Club. Only 500 bottles were made and if there is any left over after this mail out it is going straight to the museum wine pallet so we can see it again down the track.
- **2025 Grenache Shiraz Mourvedre** – Pre-release – This wine is proving to be a popular blend with past wines rating well in both Jame Halliday and Ray Jordan tastings. This wine should be no different. Soft, plush, red fruits of the Grenache paired with dark fruits and pepper spice of the Shiraz and savoury, dusty tannins of the Mourvedre make this wine layered and complex. Suited to drinking now or will cellar just fine.
- **2023 Cabernet Sauvignon** - New to cellar door – Winter months call for rich comfort food paired with big, bold wines that warm the soul, and that is exactly what this Cabernet delivers. Crafted from premium fruit sourced from a mature vineyard in Chittering at the northern end of the Perth Hills, it offers a beautiful balance of dark berry flavours, structure, and spice. This release is particularly special, as it marks the very last of our Cabernets made from Perth Hills fruit, making it a true collector's piece for your winter table or cellar before it's gone for good.
- **2023 Durif** – New to cellar door - If you are looking for the ultimate winter warmer, our latest Durif is built for the coldest of nights. True to its reputation, this vintage is a big, dark, and wonderfully robust wine, packed with intense black fruit flavours, rich tannins, and a hint of savory spice. It is the absolute perfect match for hearty stews, slow-cooked meats, or simply enjoying by the fire. Durif has long been a favourite in our portfolio for its unapologetic boldness.
